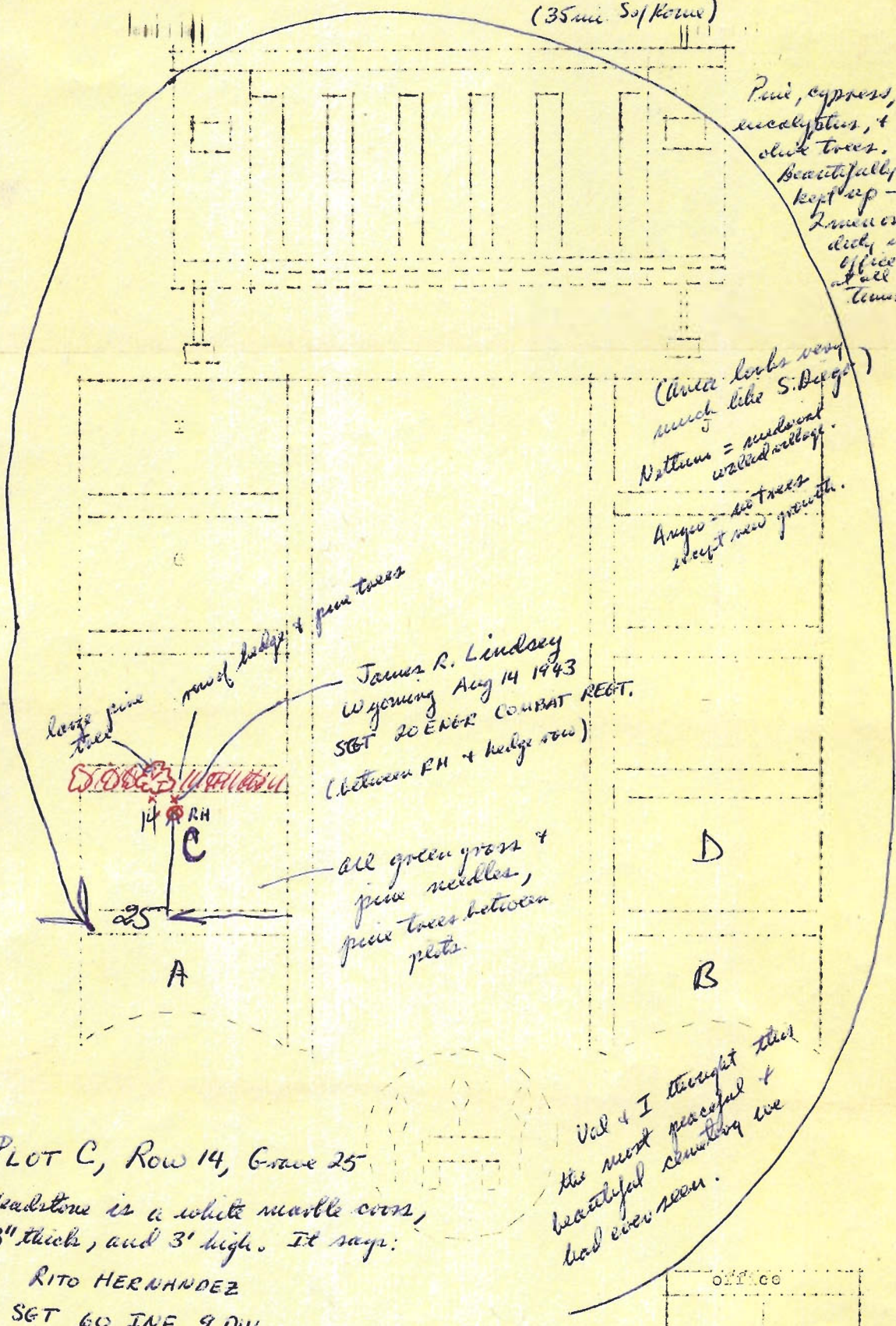


NETTUNO, ITALY
