They are all very nice.

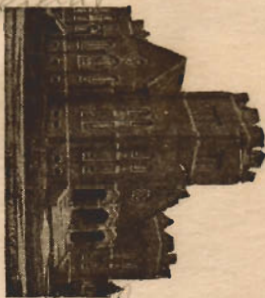
Incidentally we spent
